

Vaco Case Study

Challenge

A client had been recently acquired and was going through a transformation. The goal was to build up its project management capability for the upcoming growth. The challenge was to prioritize dozens of projects and plan resources. To add complexity - in parallel, the client was going through an Agile transformation. Vaco was asked to organize and categorize the enterprise portfolio of projects and develop a prioritization and management framework for effective Agile execution.

Solution

Vaco recommended a custom Business Change Planning and Management framework that would give product owners a clear and consistent approach to prioritize features across the portfolio. A simple solution that would be easy to learn and could be used right away. An approach that gave a company-wide long-term detailed view of the changes the company was about to undergo.

Results
